



Hand sanitiser provided should be used on entering, with hands washed before leaving Toilets and all touch points should be cleaned at the end of each session. | Amber | Sanitiser points to be checked/topped-up weekly |





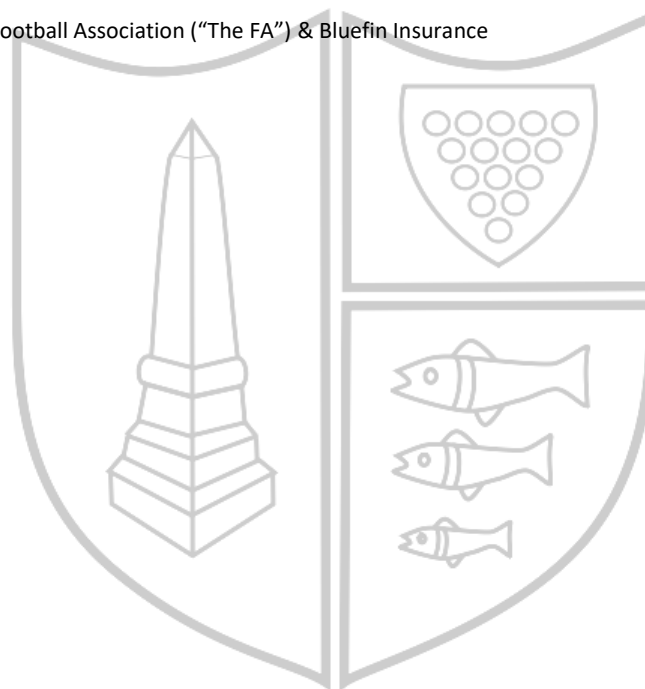
